### 6 Ways you can be involved: **THERE'S SOMETHING FOR EVERYONE TO DO!**

- 1) pick up a shopping list in the narthex and buy a few things - no contribution is too small – be sure to check expiry dates on items. **Bring donations to the lounge off the narthex anytime from now until Wednesday, Dec. 8.**
- 2) adopt a child to **buy a gift** for – the list will be in the narthex on Nov. 14 . One gift per child should be wrapped and delivered to the church by Wednesday, Dec. 8 with a tag showing the hamper #, age and gender of the child (hamper #6B, boy 3).
- 3) make a donation to Immanuel, clearly marked for Christmas hampers - no contribution is too small. Place in the offering plate in the narthex.
- 4) **knit** mitts, scarves, or toques for adults and children, esp. young children
- 5) come on Weds., Dec. 15 at 10:00 a.m. to **pack hampers** and share some Christmas cheer with others. We need some strong folks to load the van for delivery and help unpack the hampers at the receiving end. We're usually done by 1:00 pm
- 6) **pray** that this ministry will touch the hearts and spirits of the recipients with God's love, joy and peace.
