## **Meeting with Dr. Judith Paulsen**

The Vestry has invited Dr. Judith Paulsen to meet with them via ZOOM on Wednesday, January 28 at 6:30 p.m. to discuss the nature and value of evangelism. Dr. Paulsen is a professor at Wycliffe College, University of Toronto and is author of a book entitled *A New and Ancient Approach to Evangelism: Rediscovering the Ways God Calls and Sends*. Last year, she attended the 2025 Diocesan Synod in Regina and gave a very inspirational talk on new ways of looking at the mission of evangelism, and on the possible strategies that Anglicans can follow to make it a practical part of their Christian lives.
