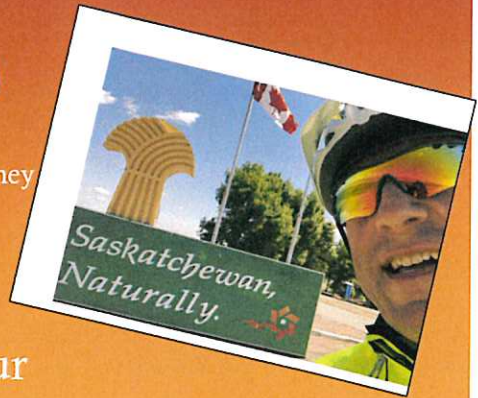

As preparations begin for my retirement and, later, in the fall, to move back to the UK, one final task will be that of saying farewell. With this in mind, I am planning a final pilgrimage cycle ride, with other riders. The ride will be in relay, to 50 churches in the diocese of Qu'Appelle.
