Alzheimer and Dementia

While the terms "Alzheimer's disease" and "dementia" are often used interchangeably, it's important to know the difference between the two.

- Dementia is not one specific disease.
 Rather, it's an umbrella term for a set of symptoms caused by physical disorders affecting the brain.
- Alzheimer's disease is the most common cause for dementia, accounting for 60-80% of all diagnoses.

Overall, know that Alzheimer's disease is a specific disease, while dementia is a general term for a group of similar diseases, of which Alzheimer's is one. In other words, every case of Alzheimer's disease is an example of dementia, but not every type of dementia is Alzheimer's.
